This Indenture made the 20th day of August in the year
 of our Lord 1765, between Isaiah Parvise, Esquire,
 Sheriff of Cumberland County in the Province of
 North Carolina of the one part; & John Brownlow of the sd. County,
 merchant, of the other part. Whereas by an act of the Parliament of
 Great Britain, made & passed in the fifth year of the reign of his
 late Majesty, King George the second, entitled, "An Act for the more
 easy recovery of debts in his Majesty's Plantations & Colonies
 in America," it is therein & thereby amongst other things enacted
