

The said Isaiah Parvise, Sheriff of the County of Cumberland in virtue & pursuance of his said Office & the Act of Parliament, & writ of fieri facias aforesaid, & for & in consideration of the said sum of Twenty one pounds Proc money to him in hand paid by the said John Brownlow before the executing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained, sold, aliened, enfeoffed, transferred, set over, assigned, conveyed & confirmed, & by virtue of his said Office & in pursuance & execution of the aforesaid writ of fieri facias as fully as he can & is thereby & by the before mentioned Act of Parliament empowered & enabled, doth by these presents grant, bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff, transfer, set over, assign, convey & confirm unto the sd. John Brownlow all that the aforesaid house called Carroll's Store house & one third of half an acre of land, situate, lying & being as before mentioned, together with all & singular the profits, emoluments, advantages, rights members, hereditaments & appurtenances whatsoever to the said Store house & one third of half an acre of land belonging or in anywise appertaining & the yearly rents & profits thereof, & of every part & parcel thereof, & all the estate, right, title & interest of the said Richard Carroll therein. To have & to hold the said Store house & one third part of half an acre of land & other the premises hereinbefore mentioned or intended to be hereby granted, bargained & sold, unto the said John Brownlow his heirs & assigns forever, to the only proper use, benefit & behoof of him the said John Brownlow his heirs & assigns forever, in as full & ample manner as he the said Isaiah Parvise, Sheriff of the County of Cumberland aforesaid, by virtue of his Office of Sheriff of the said County & in pursuance & execution of the said writ of fieri facias is — thereby enabled & empowered to convey, alter, transfer & charge the same house & one third part of half an acre of land with the appurtenances & every part & parcel thereof, unto the said John Brownlow, his heirs & assigns forever. And the said Isaiah Parvise, Sheriff of the County aforesaid doth hereby covenant, promise & grant, to & with the said John Brownlow his heirs & assigns, that he the said John Brownlow his heirs & assigns, may from time to time & at all times hereafter, have, hold, occupy, possess & enjoy the premises with the appurtenances & every part & parcel thereof free & clear of & from all & all manner of incumbrances had, made, done or committed by him the said Sheriff or by any other person or persons by his order, means or procurement.
